# give Volunteers FUN program & event opportunities!

**Daddy Daughter Date Night ★ February ★ The CORE** This 2 ½-hour event is held on a Friday evening for participants ages 4-14. Volunteers help check-in guests, serve food and drinks, organize games/dancing and help with clean up.



**Mom & Son Night ★ March ★ The CORE** This 3-hour event is held on a Friday evening for participants ages 6 and up. Volunteers will help organize sport-related or mind-challenging team games, may help assist the entertainer if necessary and help serve food and drinks as well as help with clean up.

**Frigid 5K ★ December ★ Centennial Campus and The CORE** This all-ages, 5K race takes place on a Sunday morning around Centennial Campus. Volunteers will help distribute water and snacks to runners, assist in calling out times or direct runners on the course.

**H2O Egg Venture ★ March or April ★ The CORE** This all-ages, 3-hour, FREE event takes place on a Saturday afternoon, usually the Saturday before Easter. Volunteers will help coordinate games, help at the craft table, serve refreshments, hand out goody bags after the egg dive and be a guide for the Easter Bunny's visit with guests.

**Family Fun Nights ★ Various Friday Nights throughout the year ★ The CORE** Family Fun Nights are FREE events for all ages usually held on Friday evenings throughout the year lasting approximately 2 to 3 hours. The events are themed to correspond with the time of year, such as "Awesome Autumn" Family Fun Night in November and "Happy New Year" Family Fun Day held in the early afternoon on New Year's Eve. Volunteers will help coordinate themed children's games, serve refreshments, oversee the "jumpie" and help with the craft activity table.

**Fall Fest ★ October ★ Centennial Park** Fall Fest is a FREE all-ages event at the Lemont Park District held on a Saturday in Centennial Park. In case of inclement weather, we will move indoors at The CORE. Volunteers will assist with the scarecrow building contest, run children's games, oversee the "jumpie", man the straw maze, serve hot dogs and drinks, and help guests with s'mores and bonfires.

**Frigid 5K ★ December ★ Centennial Park** The Frigid 5K is a run on the beautiful Centennial Campus and takes place the first Sunday in December. Volunteers may help with check-in, distribute event bags, pass out water at stations throughout the course, announce times, give directions to runners and help with post-race refreshments.

**Senior Events ★ Year-Round ★ The CORE and Centennial Building** The Lemont Park District has several fantastic programs and activities specifically geared towards the Seniors (participants ages 55 and up) of Lemont! Some events in which we'll need assistance are the Senior Holiday Party, held in the afternoon in the beginning of December. Volunteers will help serve food and drinks as well as assist with any other items.

**Preschool ★ Various Days September - May ★ Centennial Building** The Lemont Park District Preschool staff and students love guest helpers! Volunteers in Preschool will read to students, help with crafts and assisting with computer skills. The preschool participants are ages 2 ½ -5 years.

**Volunteer Coach – Youth Sports ★ Seasonal ★ Various Parks** Knowledgeable Volunteers share their know-how and experience with others by coaching various Lemont Park District Youth Sport Programs such as Recreation League Basketball and Flag Football for participants ages 5-14.

**Day Camp ★ June-August ★ Centennial Park** Volunteers will assist in implementing daily activities, crafts and games with camp participants ages 5-12.

**Trips ★ Year-Round ★ Various locations** Volunteers will assist in the implementation of numerous trips geared towards a variety of age groups, are offered throughout the year such as a Teen Horseback Riding Day Trip and a Senior Four Winds Casino Day Trip.



**Pack the Parks ★ June, July and August ★ Various Parks** Pack the Parks are FREE, all-ages, Summer events that feature a live band, the showing of a family friendly-movie and free hot dogs and lemonade. Set in the great outdoors, Pack the Parks are generally held once a month during the middle of the week in the Summer. Volunteers are needed to help with children's games; face painting; serving food and drinks and cleaning up.

**Park Beautification ★ Year-Round ★ Various Parks** Volunteers will work along side our maintenance department assisting with park clean up and other projects

**Breakfast with Santa ★ December ★ The CORE** Breakfast with Santa is a wonderful holiday tradition at The Lemont Park District. This all-ages event is held on a the first Saturday in December. Volunteers will help with check-in, replenish and/or serve the breakfast buffet and drinks, run children's games, assist the photographer, help with holiday crafts and lend a hand with clean-up.
