LEMONT PARK DISTRICT

Purpose

The Lemont Park District was organized and established as a separate unit of local government in 1966 by a referendum.

MISSION: The mission of the Lemont Park District is to provide the very best parks and recreation experiences to the community while being safe and fiscally responsible.

VISION: The Lemont Park District strives to be *collaborative, proactive and progressive* in serving our community.

Population

The Lemont Park District's population as of 4/1/2020 per the 2020 census is 22,645*.

**This figure has been derived from projected populations based off of Census reports along with other database information as it relates to the area in which the District serves.*

Assessed Valuation

The estimated equalized assessed valuation for real estate for 2025 is \$1,334,298,259.

Tax Rate

The estimated property tax rate for 2025 is 0.44 per \$1,000 of assessed value.

Current Budget

The operating budget for the fiscal year 2026 is \$7,752,277 (less Debt and Capital.) The fiscal year begins January 1 and ends December 31.

Staff

The Park District has an appointed Executive Director responsible for the administration of the Park District. The District employs 26 full time staff and between 175-300 part-time and seasonal staff members.

Board of Commissioners and Administrative Staff

The Lemont Park district is governed by five elected residents of Lemont who voluntarily give their services to the community. The Commissioners elect a President and Vice President and appoint a Treasurer and Board Secretary. The Park Board holds its regular meetings on the fourth Tuesday of each month at 6:00 p.m. at the Lemont Park District Canal Center, 55 Stephen Street, Lemont. Date & time subject to change. Please see individual agendas for specific meeting location and information. Residents are invited to attend and are welcome to make suggestions or comments to improve the programs or facilities offered.

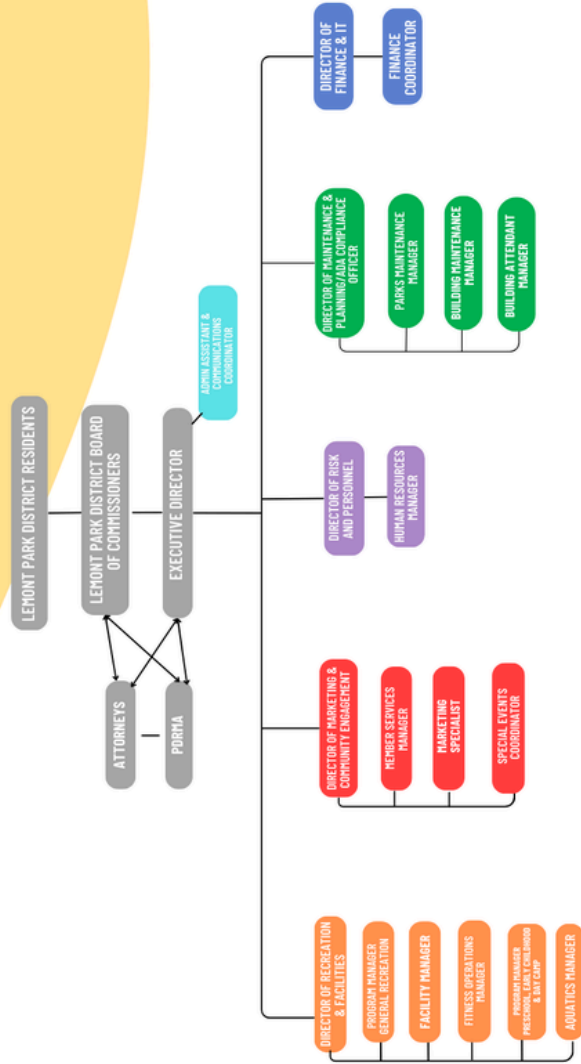
LEMONT PARK DISTRICT ORGANIZATIONAL CHART
