Notice is hereby given that the office of the Lemont Park District at 16028 127th Street, Lemont, Illinois will be open during regular business hours from 9 a.m. until 5 p.m. beginning Tuesday, November 19, 2024, through Friday, November 22, 2024 and Monday, November 25, 2024, for the purpose of accepting objections to candidate petitions for the Consolidated General Election to be held on April 1, 2025. Please note Lemont Park District Business Office is closed November 23 and 24, 2024.

Any objections to nominating petitions must be filed with the Lemont Park District (who received the original petition) within 5 business days following the last day of the petition filing period, as provided above.
