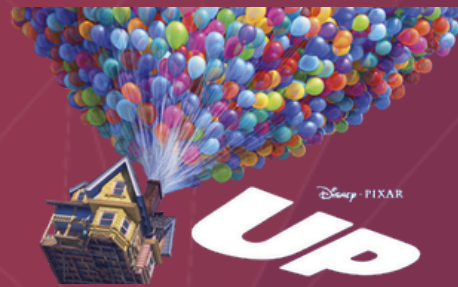

Centennial Outdoor Pool Rentals

Reservations

- Outdoor Pool rentals are open for reservation.
- You will have full access to all working attractions at the pool and locker rooms
- You will be provided three (3) tables and fifty (50) chairs to use for the duration of the rental
- This rental is only applicable to the area of the Outdoor Pool space, this does not include surrounding playgrounds/buildings

Cancellations

- Cancellations must be submitted in writing to the Aquatics Manager, by the person who signed the contract, by the Friday before the party at 12PM
- In lieu of cancellations, the indoor pool is available to move the party inside
- The Park District is not responsible for the option of keeping the party outside and inclement weather occurs. No partial refunds will be given if party moves indoors

Frequently Asked Questions

- **Food/Drink:** Food and non-alcoholic drinks are allowed to be brought in during the rental. Food and drink must stay in the Concessions table area and not be brought into the pool water and/or into the grass area.
- **Outside equipment:** Non-electronic equipment/attractions are allowed to be brought in. The person who signs the contract bears all responsibility for the upkeep and any damage/injuries that may be incurred related to these items.
- **Setup:** The person who signed the contract may come in for prep 15 minutes prior to the rental start time.
- **Capacity:** Private Parties include admission for up to 100 guests, all guests (including guardians) are included in the head count. This also applies to those not going into the water.
- **Extra time:** The extra hour add-on must be purchased with the initial payment for the rental.
- **Drugs/Alcohol:** The use, possession of being under the influence of alcohol or other illegal substances will result in the immediate removal from the facility and the proper authorities will be notified.
- **Rules:** During the duration of the rental, all guests must adhere to the rules as enforced by the lifeguards on duty.

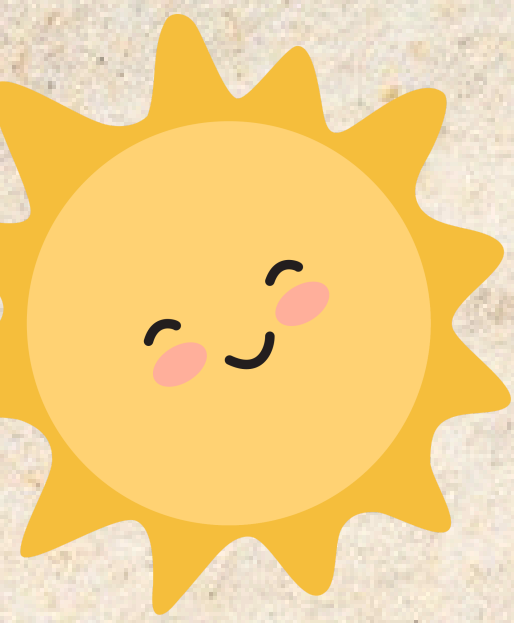

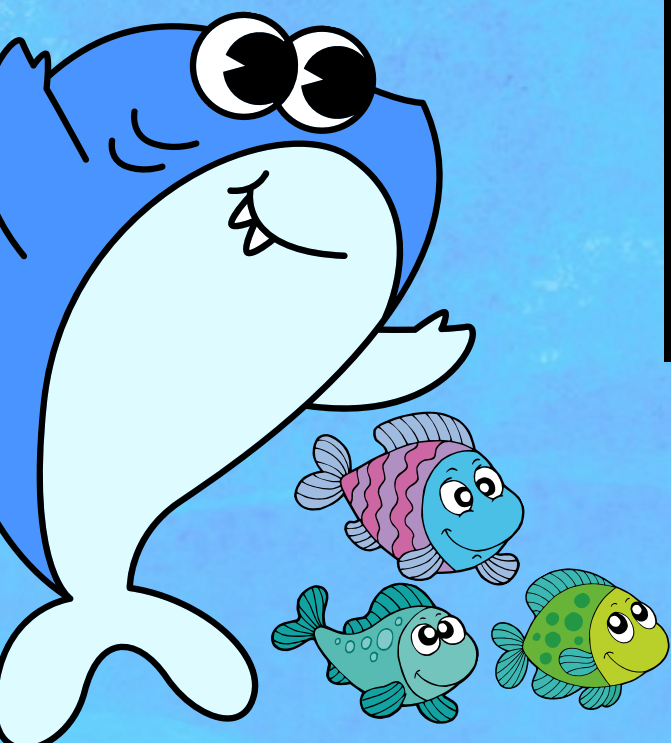

PRESCHOOL ACADEMY

HAND IN HAND, TOGETHER WE GROW!

Terrific Two's

Terrific Twos introduces children turning two by September 1st to a preschool setting, focusing on easing separation, fostering independence, and developing communication skills. Each class follows a monthly theme with songs, stories, socialization, and playtime. Fine and gross motor skills are enhanced through games and crafts. Classes meet twice a week in the mornings for 1 hour and 15 minutes.

Young 3's

The Young 3's class is for children turning three between September 1st and December 31st. Meeting on Tuesdays and Thursdays for 1.5 hours, this class fosters socialization, independence, and early learning in a fun, caring environment. Focus areas include sharing, taking turns, and separation from parents. Activities feature art, dramatic play, large motor play, stories, songs, and an introduction to colors, shapes, numbers, letters, and name recognition.

3 Year-Old Program

The 3-Year-Old class is for children who turn three by September 1st and meets twice a week for two hours. Sessions are available Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday mornings. Through interactive play, children explore numbers, shapes, colors, and letters while developing social skills. Activities include creative art, physical education, music, dramatic play, and practicing name recognition, tracing, writing, and simple worksheets.

4 Year-Old Program

The 4-Year-Old class is for children turning four by September 1st and meets three times a week for 2.5 hours. Class is offered on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday mornings. The curriculum includes reviewing colors, shapes, phonetic awareness, and printing the alphabet and numbers 1-20. Activities feature worksheets, creative art, large motor skills, science, STEM, and music, all designed to promote independent thinking and kindergarten readiness.

Finally Five Program

Finally Fives is for children turning five between September 1st and December 31st. Classes meet three times a week, Monday, Wednesday, and Friday, for 2.5 hours in the morning. The curriculum emphasizes phonics for reading, writing, and verbal skills, along with reviewing colors, numbers, shapes, and letters through worksheets and motor activities. Science, STEM, music, and socialization help foster independence and a positive self image, preparing students for kindergarten readiness.

Preschool Enrichment Program

The Preschool Enrichment Program is for students in the Lemont Park District's 4-Year-Old and Finally Fives preschool programs. After attending their regular morning class (Monday, Wednesday, Friday, 9 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.), students can extend their day until 2:30 p.m. The program offers a balance of Illinois CORE standards in literacy, math, and science, along with drama, music, and creative movement. A 30-minute supervised lunch is included between the morning and afternoon sessions.

Preschool PLUS

Preschool Plus offers an opportunity to expand your child's learning by adding one or two days to their current program. Three-Year-Olds can add one day for a 3-day week, while Four Year-Olds and Finally Fives can add two days for a 5-day week. The extended curriculum includes art, music, science, computers, and indoor/outdoor physical activities.

Kids Connect

Parents don't need to return between programs. If a student is enrolled in both morning preschool and afternoon enrichment, they will stay with staff for a supervised lunch and be escorted to the afternoon program. Students should bring a nut-free lunch and drink, as lunches won't be refrigerated. Kids Connect is available at no cost to enrolled Preschool Academy students.

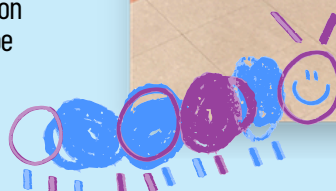

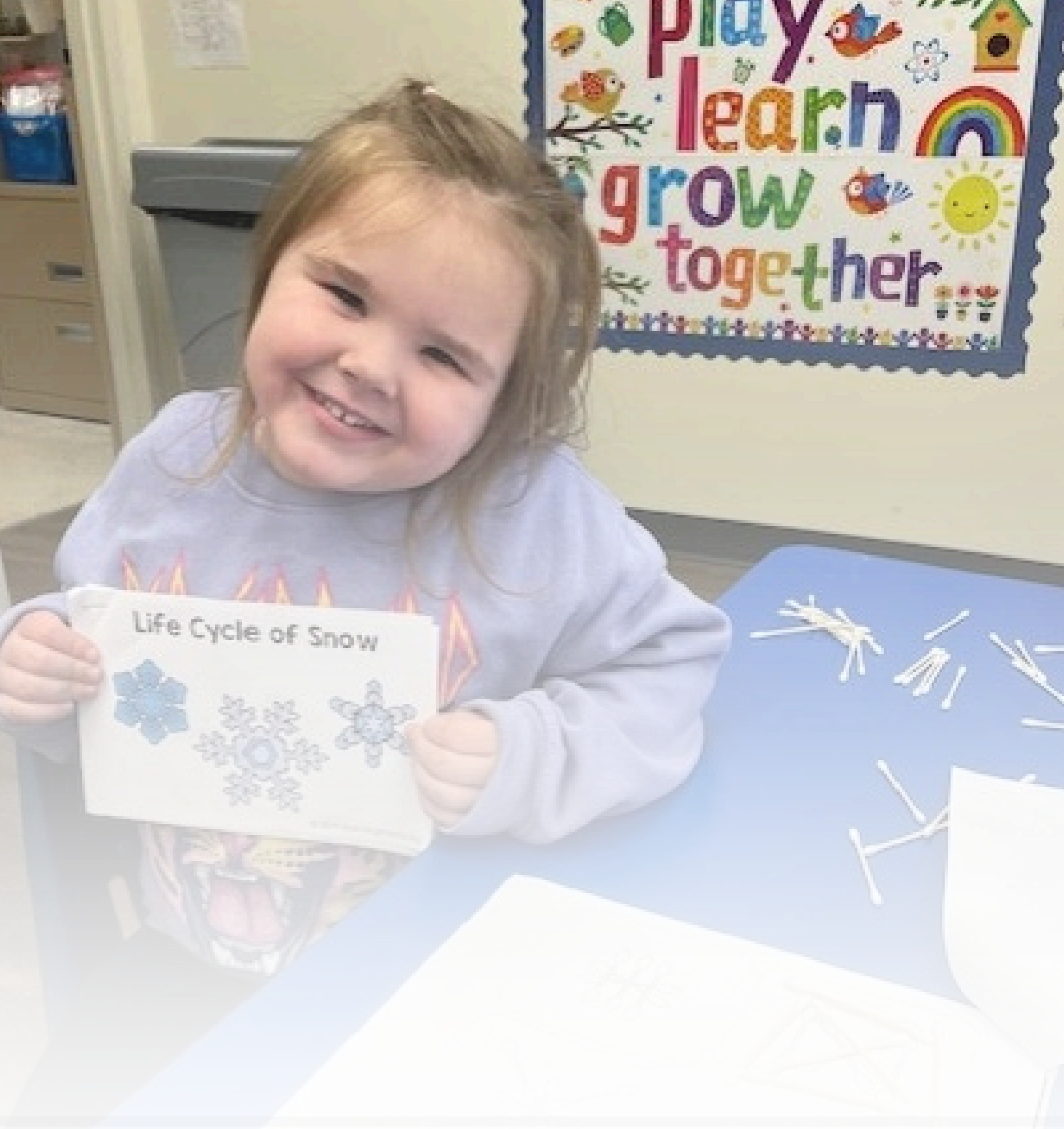
Preschool Enrichment

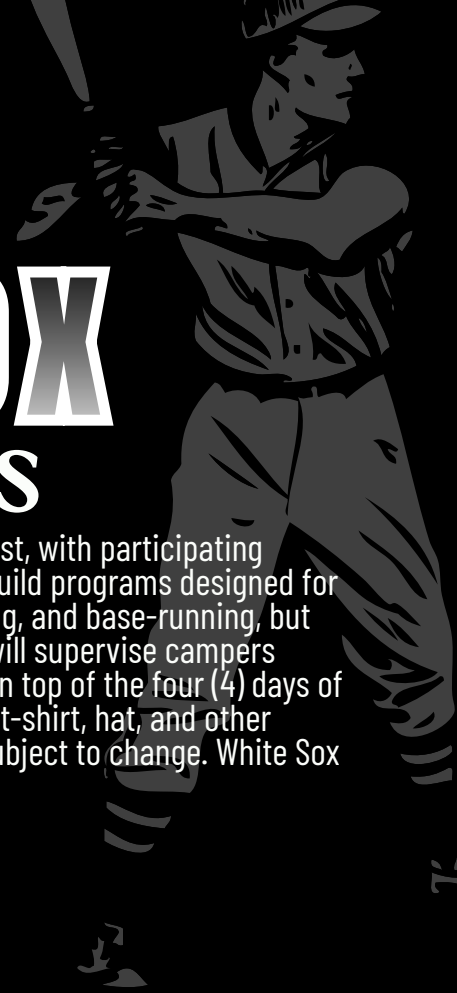

- Lemont Park District reserves the right to request proof of residency.
- All new households or first time registrants must provide proof of residency. Proof of residency may be your Cook County tax bill, voters registration card, utility bill, rental agreement or closing docs, along with drivers license and birth certificates for children. This can be done in person at The CORE or the Centennial Community Center. Or you may visit www.LemontParkDistrict.org to create a household and upload required documents. - When completing your registration form, you MUST provide ALL required information.
- Participants must be of requirement age by the first day of class.
- If a program is filled that you have requested, you must put your name on the waitlist.
- Resident fees are for Lemont residents only. Non-resident fees are higher than resident fees.
- Receipts for registrations will be emailed unless otherwise directed.
- All checks must be made out to Lemont Park District.
- If you do not remember your username and password, please visit www.LemontParkDistrict.org. Click on the Register Now button on the left side. Click on My Account. From there, you can request a new username or password.

It will take up to 24 hours to be approved, Monday-Friday. If you create an account on the weekend, it will be completed on the following Monday. The Park District reserves the right to dismiss a participant from a program if their behavior or language is deemed inappropriate by staff. Lemont Park District applies a positive approach to discipline. Lemont Park District reserves the right to dismiss a participant whose behavior endangers his or her own safety or the safety of others.

Cancellations/Refund Policy

Lemont Park District reserves the right to cancel, postpone any classes or rentals, or combine classes as necessary. Classes may be canceled due to low enrollments. No refunds will be issued once a class has begun. Refund requests must be submitted to The CORE desk staff in person or via phone or email during normal business hours. Requests received via email after normal business hours will be dated for the next business day. Credits or make-up classes are not available if a class is missed. If the Park District cancels a trip or program, a full refund will be issued. **Classes, camps, athletic leagues, or programs**- The cancellation deadline for a full refund is 7 days prior to the start of the class/ program. After that, a \$10 processing fee for each class canceled and any other associated costs (uniforms, supplies, etc.) which have already been incurred will be deducted from the refund amount. No refunds will be issued after a class/camp/league/ program has begun. **Aquatic Center Passes** - No refunds will be issued after the first day the pool opens for the summer. **Preschool** - The Deposit Fee of \$100 is NON-REFUNDABLE. **CORE Memberships** - There are no refunds for CORE Memberships. All cancellation requests will be processed the last day of the month and future billings will not occur. **Senior Trips/Events**: A \$10 processing fee for each trip/event canceled and any other associated costs (travel, food, tickets, etc.) which have already been incurred will be deducted from the refund amount. **Medical Drops** - Prorated refunds will be issued upon receipt of a note from a doctor stating the individual can no longer participate in the program. The refund will be prorated from the date of receipt of the doctor's note. **Refund Methods** - Household Credit - Amount of refund will be credited to your Household Account for future use. Refunds - Customers will be credited in the same manner payment was received such as Visa, MasterCard, Discover or American Express. Customers who paid by cash or check will receive a check. Check refunds are processed monthly.

Minimum/Maximum Class Numbers

Each program offered has a minimum number of participants needed for the class to proceed. To maintain our fiscal responsibility to the residents of Lemont, we will cancel classes or programs that fail to meet the minimum requirement. The maximum number represents the highest amount of registrants allowed in the class.

Lemont residents contribute to the overall financing of the Lemont Park District through property taxes. Because of this, they receive resident pricing for classes, programs and memberships and receive priority registration. Non-residents must pay the non-resident rate.

NSF Checks

Checks returned for insufficient funds will be assessed a \$25 service fee.

Observation Policy

We love parents but... We ask that anyone who is not registered for a class remain outside of the classroom/gym during the program time. This allows your child to enjoy class without distractions.

Participant Illness/Attendance Guidelines

Participants who have a fever or are sick should not attend classes or programs. It is the Lemont Park District's goal to provide a healthy, safe place for our participants and members. The District asks that all participants and members be free from the following symptoms for at least 24 hours before attending the District. Picnic Permit Reservations began on January 2, 2026 for the 2026 season. All reservations are taken on a first-come, first serve basis. All fees are due when making reservations. Persons using Lemont Park District picnic sites are required to provide the Park District with insurance information regarding any rentals of inflatable apparatuses, carnival games or other rental items to be placed on the District property.

Program Cancellation

The decision to cancel most programs due to low enrollment will be made at least seven days prior to the program start date.
